

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CHRISTIAN?

The crucial parts of this belief are that:

Jesus is the Son of God

Jesus lived a perfect human life

After being buried in a tomb for 3 days, Jesus was resurrected - He fully came back to life by the power of God. He was seen by His friends, He ate meals with people, He walked around and He taught people more details about the kingdom of God in heaven. Jesus rose to heaven to be with the Father and to send a helper - the Holy Spirit

After Jesus spent time with His followers in His resurrected form, He was seen by many witnesses to physically rise up to heaven so He could join His Father in ruling over all creation. But He promised to send His followers the Holy Spirit who would empower them and every person from then on that puts their trust in Jesus as Saviour and Lord of their life. The Holy Spirit gives Christians the power needed to follow Jesus' example of obeying God and to begin the transformation from living in sin and death to living in truth and life.

Jesus will return to earth a final time as King

The story isn't finished yet. At an unknown time, Jesus will return to earth and establish His rule as the King of all creation. He will defeat all that is evil and destroy its influence, and will rule fully and forever with God's justice and righteousness. Those who choose to reject God and continue living in rebellion against Him will perish. But all those who have believed Jesus for salvation and have been restored to relationship with God will live with Him in this perfected era of eternity - heaven.
